After studying English at IH Brisbane or Cairns, undertake a professional, corporate internship anywhere in Australia. IH's partners in this programme are specialist companies arranging professional internships for students and young professionals from around the world.



Features of an English and Professional Internship Programme

- Internships are structured training & development programmes within a company.
- Unpaid Internships are available in a wide range of fields – Accounting, Aged Care and Child Care, Agriculture, Arts, Banking & Finance, Education, Engineering, Environmental Science, Forestry, Government, Graphic Design, Health, Hospitality and Tourism, Information Technology, Law & Politics, Linguistics, Sales and Marketing, Media and Journalism, Marine Science, Photography, Retail, Sociology, Sport, Telecommunications ...plus many more.
- Paid internships are available in hospitality fields. Students undertaking this program will be paid the minimum Australian award wage for their age.
- Unpaid Internships can range in length from one month to one year.
- Field of placement must relate to the student's current field of study or work.
- Paid Hospitality Internships can be for 6, 9 or 12 month placements.
- Students need IH Upper Intermediate to Advanced English skills to undertake an internship program in Australia. (IH can provide a pre-test for students or agents).

Costs

- English Language Courses range in cost from \$260 - \$310 per week depending on course length.
- Enrolment Fee \$180 applies to all courses (payable once only).
- Material Fees \$70 - \$180 per course depending on length.

Visa Information

Students can do an Internship on a Working Holiday Visa, Tourist Visa (must change Visa on shore), Student Visa (subject to conditions) and Special Programmes 416 Visa. The 416 Visa is recommended.

• Working Holiday Visa

Maximum 12 weeks English and maximum 12 weeks Internship.

• Tourist Visa

Do maximum 12 weeks English then change to Special Programmes 416 Visa and do more English if needed plus Internship.

• Student Visa

Internships can be done during scheduled study breaks or at the end of a student's course (before Visa expires).

• Special Programme 416 Visa

A visa specifically designed for Internship programmes. It allows English study for a maximum of 15 weeks and then a maximum of 37 weeks Internship.
